Calling Meeting to Order / Presentations / Proclamation:

- 1. Call to Order Mayor Pro-Tem Phillips called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm Invocation The invocation was led by Councilman Bob Pannkuk
- 2. Pledges of Allegiance to the United State and Texas Flags Mayor Pro-Tem Phillips led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States and Texas Flags.
- **3. Proof of Posting of Notice of Meeting City Secretary** Mayor Pro-Tem Phillips noted the proof of posting of meeting by City Secretary Leath Robinson

Verification of Quorum – Mayor Pro-Tem Phillips noted the quorum of two councilmembers constituting a quorum for purposes of canvassing an election (per election code Sec. 67.004) however not enough for a quorum to conduct the remaining city business on the agenda for that meeting.

4. Canvas of votes from municipal election on May 5, 2018.

Unofficial Precinct Report for Mayor shows Mayor Steven Bolin with 134 votes total at 53.39% of the votes, Jackie M. Isham with 21 votes total at 8.37% and Willie Johnson with 96 votes total at 38.25% of the votes.

Unofficial Precinct Report for City Council Place 2 shows Jay Barker with 80 votes total and 31.87% of the votes, Jane Blackerby with 78 votes at 31.08%, Margy S. Hall with 40 votes at 15.94% and Michael Pye with 53 votes at 21.12% of the votes.

Unofficial Precinct Report for City Council Place 4 shows Darrell Grintz with 147 votes at 58.57% of the votes and Leonard Phillips with 104 votes at 41.43% of the votes.

Mayor Pro-Tem Leonard Phillips made a motion to approve the results from the May 5th Election. Seconded by Councilman Bob Pannkuk. Both were in favor and the motion carried.
