Public Hearing:

Public hearing for proposed Re-Zoning of 201 N. Pecan - Mayor Bolin called the public hearing to order at 5:30 pm. Residents voiced concerns to council, as did property owner Darrell Grintz. City Administrator William Linn recommended to deny rezoning the property to C-1, leaving the property as SF-1 and for the Council to grant Mr. Grintz a variance to build a ten foot fence. Seconded by Councilman Pannkuk, Mayor Bolin called for a vote—3 For, 2 Abstain, motion carried. Mayor Bolin adjourned the public hearing and moved into the Council meeting's regular session.
