MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL SESSION

1. Invocation, Pledges of Allegiance to the United Sates and Texas Flags, Call to Order, Proof of posting of Notice of Meeting, Verification of Quorum Mayor Pye called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

2. Discuss and consider adoption of Resolution 10262021-1 regarding Police Department Vehicle Financing with Government Capital

Councilmember Wilcox motioned to adopt Resolution 10262021-1. Second by Councilmember Martin. Mayor Pye called for a vote – all were in favor and the motion carried.

3. Discuss and consider approval of Contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for professional services regarding Texas Water Development Board's CWSRF Collection System Improvements Project

Councilmember Martin motioned to approve contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for professional services regarding Texas Water Development Board's CWSRF Collection System Improvements Project.
