

Canceling Election of Mayor and Councilmembers And Declaring Unopposed Candidates Elected to Office

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEONARD CANCELING THE MAY 7, 2022 REGULAR ELECTION AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE

WHEREAS, in these circumstances Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the Election Code authorizes the governing body to declare by order or ordinance each unopposed candidate elected to the office; and

WHEREAS, City Council issued an Amended Order of Election on February 8, 2022, for the purpose of electing two (2) City Council members at-large and Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the filing deadline for placement on the ballot has passed and each candidate is unopposed for election to office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 7, 2022 regular election, are hereby declared elected to office:
