



## RESOLUTION 51022-3R

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE 2022 LOCAL EXEMPTION ON FIXED AMOUNT ADDITIONAL FOR HOMESTEADED PROPERTIES ONLY FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE DISABLED PERSONS OR OVER SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OF AGE WITHIN THE CITY OF LEONARD, AS PERMITTED BY SECTION 11.13(d) OF THE TEXAS PROPERTY TAX CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Leonard, Texas approved by action on May 10, 2022 at a regular scheduled council meeting to consider the authorization of granting property tax exemptions to individuals who are disabled or over sixty-five (65) years of age owning a residence homestead within the jurisdictional boundaries of City of Leonard, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council may grant or deny an additional local exemption for the Homesteaded Properties only for individuals who are disabled persons or over sixty-five (65) years of age located within the jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, for 2022 a Local Option in the amount of \$ 5,000 of all qualified homesteaded properties and acknowledge the minimum value of the exemption must be \$3,000.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS**

**APPROVED**, the granting of a 2022 a Local Option in the amount of \$ 5,000 of all qualified homesteaded properties and acknowledge the minimum value of the exemption must be \$3,000.
