



RESOLUTION 51022-4R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE 2022 LOCAL EXEMPTION ON HOMESTEAD PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF LEONARD, AS PERMITTED BY SECTION 11.13(n) OF THE TEXAS PROPERTY TAX CODE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Leonard, Texas approved by action on May 10, 2022 at a regular scheduled council meeting to consider the authorization of granting property tax exemptions to individuals owning a residence homestead within the jurisdictional boundaries of City of Leonard, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may grant or deny an additional local exemption on homestead properties located within the jurisdiction; and

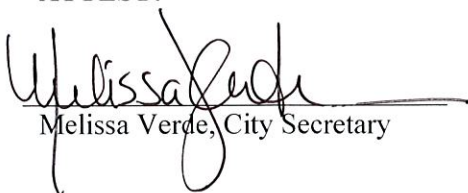
WHEREAS, for 2022 a Local Option of 2 percent of the appraised value of all homesteaded properties and acknowledge the minimum value of the exemption must be \$5,000.00.

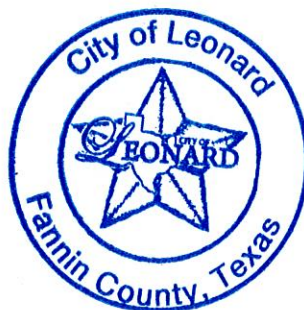
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS

APPROVED, the 2022 Local Exemption on Homestead Properties within the jurisdictional boundaries within the City of Leonard of 2 percent of the appraised value of all homesteaded properties and acknowledge the minimum value of the exemption must be \$5,000.00.
