 - i. The proposed tax rate shall not exceed the tax rate of \$0.549594/\$100 of taxable value.

 - I. Discussion took place and a motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Stephens to adopt Ordinance 240917-1, seconded by Councilmember Hanson, the motion carried 4-1 with Councilmember Phillips against.

 - I. Mayor Pro Tem Stephens thanked those who attended the budget workshops & participated. Mayor Pye commended the Council and everyone for their work on the budget.
