

RESOLUTION NO. 260217-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS, DESIGNATING AUTHORIZED SIGNATORY FOR THE CONTRACTUAL AND FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT MITIGATION PROGRAM AND CONTRACT NUMBER 23-160-170-F627; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Leonard, Texas (“City”) desires to develop a thriving, viable community, strengthen infrastructure, provide a suitable living environment, and expand economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City to apply for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program Resilient Communities Program Non-Research and Development Mitigation Funding; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a CDBG-MIT grant award (the “Grant”) to provide financial assistance with funds appropriated under the Further Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Requirements Act related to disaster relief, long-term recovery, restoration of infrastructure and housing, economic revitalization, mitigation, and affirmatively furthering fair housing in the most impacted and distressed areas resulting from major declared disasters that occurred in 2015, 2016, and 2017 pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint persons to execute contractual and financial documents pertaining to the Grant from the Texas General Land Office under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development’s Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program; and

WHEREAS, all funds shall be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local, and programmatic requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEONARD, TEXAS, THAT:


Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The findings recited above are incorporated as if fully set forth in the body of this Resolution.

Section 2. Authorization to Act as Signatory on Contractual and Financial Documents. The City Administrator of the City is hereby designated and authorized to act as signatory on all contractual and financial documents pertaining to the Grant, on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
